McFarlane takes a critical account of Schepisi's film output—including such standouts as *The Chant of Jimmie Blacksmith*, *Plenty*, *Roxanne*, *Six Degrees of Separation*, *Mr. Baseball*, and *Last Orders*—and he augments analysis with interviews with the director. By discussing the production histories and both critical and popular receptions, McFarlane's study shines a new light on Schepisi's work and his rise to prominence in the global film industry.
